1. The Municipal Auditor (and other Auditors, if any) shall perform the following minimum duties as well as those prescribed by applicable law, subject to the review and approval of the Mayor and Borough Council:

The Borough Auditor will audit the financial statements of the Borough of Mantoloking for the year ended December 31, 2023. The document that is submitted to the Borough of Mantoloking will include additional information in the Supplementary Schedules and Data and in the Schedules of Expenditures of Federal and State Awards that will be subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the Auditor's audit of the financial statements.
